Marie-Luise is German by nationality but has residence in both UK and South Germany.

Her first serious riding lesson in dressage was at a very well known stable in Karlsruhe with **Egon von Neindorff**; he was famous in the 60's and 70's for the string of horses he had.

Marie-Luise began to ride in the 60's in her hometown Wildbad, then changed to stables in Ludwigsburg because of her trainers, who were Herr Aust and Herr Biedermann.

Later Marie-Luise teamed up with **Clare Blaskey** to train her horse *Blue Chip*.

When Clare Blaskey started her feed company **Blue Chip Feed Limited** in 1996, the company was named after her horse *Blue Chip*.

He was an amazing small show horse with fantastic movements, a big heart and good brain. Eventually *Blue Chip* became best-trained show horse at the National Championships 6 times and 4 times at the **Royal Windsor Show**.



Marie-Luise travelled to Florida in the United States in 2003 and 2004 and gave two clinics and private lessons to trainers and pupils. One of her well-known students was **Adriana Sassoon**, daughter in law of **Vidal Sassoon**.



Marie-Luise prepares links on an individual basis to find horses, sourcing them from Germany.

Marie-Luise also offers a training service in England if required for English riders.
